## Sunday School MEMORY WORK GUIDELINES for THIRD GRADERS

1. **ALL** memory work for Sunday School must be recited to a 3rd Grade Sunday School teacher.  
*SUNDAY SCHOOL VERSES CANNOT BE RECITED TO A PARENT!*
2. The verses in this book are from various versions. If you prefer for your child to learn the verses in the KJV, they may do so. It will count toward their trophy.
3. Memory work **CANNOT** be recited over the phone.
4. To enhance the connection between the memory verse and the lesson, we encourage each 3rd grader to stay on schedule and not move ahead.
5. A trophy will be given to all children who complete the Sunday School memory work for the months of September through June. **ALL** memory work must be completed by June 27, 2010.
6. **KEEP IN MIND: ALL 5th Graders who have completed 1st-5th Grade memory work will receive a Bible engraved with their name and signed by Pastor Brunson.**

## God's Gift of Salvation

WEEK	<b>Bible Theme: I can show God's love.</b>
1ST	This is what the Lord Almighty says: "...show mercy and compassion to one another." Zechariah 7:9
2ND	Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth. 1 John 3:18
3RD	Each of us should please his neighbor for his good, to build him up. Romans 15:2
4TH	I tell you who hear me: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. Luke 6:27-28

WEEK	<b>Bible Theme: I can trust in God's love and power.</b>
1ST	Sing to the Lord, bless His name; proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day. Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples. And refuge in the day of my trouble. Psalm 96:2-3
2ND	But I will sing of Your power; Yes, I will sing aloud of Your mercy in the morning; For You have been my defense and refuge in the day of my trouble. Psalm 59:16

2ND	You shall walk after the Lord your God and fear Him, and keep His commandments and obey His voice; you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him. <span style="float: right;">Deuteronomy 13:4</span>
3RD	Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them; for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you. <span style="float: right;">Deuteronomy 31:6</span>
4TH	Teach me, O Lord, the way of Your statutes, and I shall keep it to the end. Give me understanding, and I shall keep Your law; indeed, I shall observe it with my whole heart. <span style="float: right;">Psalm 119:33-34</span>

## NOVEMBER

MONTH	<b>You must say all of Psalm 100 at one time for credit.</b>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands.</li><li>2) Serve the Lord with gladness: come before His presence with singing.</li><li>3) Know ye that the Lord he is God: it is He that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture.</li><li>4) Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise: be thankful unto Him, and bless His name.</li><li>5) For the Lord is good; his mercy is everlasting; and His truth endureth to all generations. <span style="float: right;">Psalm 100</span></li></ol>	

## DECEMBER

WEEK	<b>Bible Theme: Jesus was born to be my Savior.</b>
1ST	And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord. Luke 2:10-11
2ND	I will praise You, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will tell of all Your marvelous works. Psalm 9:1
3RD	And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him. Colossians 3:17
4TH	Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6

## MAY

WEEK	<b>Bible Theme: I can tell others about Jesus.</b>
1ST	For you will be His witness to all men of what you have seen and heard. Acts 22:15
2ND	Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity. Ephesians 5:15-16
3RD	And we urge you, brothers, warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be patient with everyone. 1 Thessalonians 5:14
4TH	How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? Romans 10:14
5TH	Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else. 1 Thessalonians 5:15

MONTH	<b>You must say all of Psalm 23 at one time for credit.</b>
<p>1) The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.</p> <p>2) He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside quiet waters.</p> <p>3) He restores my soul; He guides me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.</p> <p>4) Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.</p> <p>5) You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You have anointed my head with oil; My cup overflows.</p> <p>6) Surely goodness and lovingkindness will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.    Psalm 23</p>	

## JANUARY

WEEK	<b>Bible Theme: Jesus shows me how to love others.</b>
1ST	For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: not of works, lest any man should boast. <span style="float: right;">Ephesians 2:8-9</span>
2ND	Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. <span style="float: right;">Revelation 3:20</span>
3RD	But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. <span style="float: right;">James 1:22</span>
4TH	Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful. <span style="float: right;">Luke 6:36</span>
5TH	For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. <span style="float: right;">John 3:16-17</span>

## FEBRUARY

WEEK	<b>Bible Theme: Jesus cares for everyone.</b>
1ST	Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous. 1 Peter 3:8
2ND	I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men 1 Timothy 2:1
3RD	Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ. Galatians 6:2
4TH	O give thanks unto the Lord, for he is good: for His mercy endures for ever. Psalm 107:1

## MARCH

WEEK	<b>Bible Theme: I can be a part of God's family.</b>
1ST	Therefore you shall obey the voice of the Lord your God, and observe His commandments and His statutes which I command you today. Deuteronomy 27:10
2ND	Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who is to come into the world. John 11:27
3RD	That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.      Philippians 2:10-11
4TH	Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies. Psalm 103:2-4
