We are so glad that you picked up a Grow in the Word Study Guide! We have designed this guide to help you grow in your knowledge of God and his Word as you study the upcoming Bible passage that will be taught in your Sunday School class.

This Bible study uses four symbols to help you go deeper in your study of God's Word: a light bulb, a question mark, a cross, and an arrow.



The light bulb is something that “shines” from the passage – something that sticks out to you as new and fresh. Since the Bible is God’s Word, every time we come to it we discover new truths about our infinitely glorious God. This could be a word that is repeated, an interesting turn of phrase, a truth you have never thought of before, something you forgot and were reminded of, etc.



Did this passage raise any questions for you? Are there any words you don’t know? Are you struggling to follow the biblical author’s train of thought? Did the passage prompt a question about who God is? Are you wondering how this passage connects to another passage in the Bible? Is there something about the context you don’t understand? The possibilities for questions are endless! Perhaps you can even ask one or two of these questions during Sunday School!



The cross reminds us that every passage of the Bible connects to the person and work of Jesus Christ. Jesus told his disciples on the road to Emmaus that the whole Bible is about him! (Luke 24:44) That means we should strive to understand how every Bible passage relates to who he is and what he has done. What in this passage helped you see more of Jesus and his cross, or what moved you to love him more?



The arrow indicates a personal implication of this passage on your life. How does the truth of this passage impact the way you think, the way you feel, the way you interact with others and with God, the way you lead your family, the way you live your life? What is God teaching you through this passage? What is he leading you to stop doing or start doing? What wrong thinking or behavior is he correcting in your life? How is this passage preparing you to live more effectively for him? These are the kinds of questions the arrow should prompt us to ask.
